Who does CRP help?

CRP serves a wide variety of people, from families with young children, the unemployed, people living with mental or physical disabilities, to seniors living on a fixed income while struggling to make ends meet. We also assist many Jewish immigrants from the former Soviet Union who are living in government housing projects. Our clients are primarily Jewish; however, CRP will provide food to anyone who asks for our help.

Why are we doing this?

For many recipients, the work of CRP means the difference between eating regularly and going without. Many of our recipient households live at or below the poverty line and are unable to purchase all of the food they need each month without the help of CRP. Others have an illness or disability that makes it difficult to get to the supermarket or do not have reliable transportation to a local grocery store.
